### New Applicant Procedure:

- Complete the application along a copy of your current certifications and driver's license.
- You will be contacted for an in-person interview by the Membership Committee.
- After your interview you will be presented as a new applicant at the next monthly Association business meeting. At this time your application will be tabled for one month while a background check and interview are conducted.
- You will need to complete and pass a physical examination and the result back to the department before you may be voted in.
- The following monthly business meeting your application for membership will be voted on by our membership.
- The final step will be to present you as a new member to the Town of Perinton Board and the receipt of the letter indicating that you have been added to the Town's Workers Compensation Policy.
- After receipt of this letter you will be able to participate in Association activities as an active member.

### Training Requirements:

- During the first 12 months a new member is required to complete:
  - Complete all of the EFA Task Book including the NYS Skills sheets,
  - The NYS Fire Fighter 1 class (Interior FF only),
  - Perform attend at least 2 live fire drills with a Chief or assigned Line Officer (Interior FF only),
  - Demonstrate competency of tools and equipment on the trucks, and
  - Receive approval from the Chief to become Interior / Exterior Qualified.
- The Association meets every 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Monday evening at 7:30pm for firematic training activities. It is highly recommended that you attend the Monday training sessions prior to your acceptance into the Association.
- Truck maintenance is conducted once a month on Sunday morning beginning at 8:00 AM. It is highly recommended that you attend as many of these sessions prior to your acceptance into the Association.

### Member Duties:

- Attend the Monthly Business Meeting held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of the month. The meetings start at 7:30pm at Station #1
- Attend and participate in the monthly training drills.
- Attend work details that are announced by the Chief during the year.
- Attend the annual hose test work detail in May.
- Attend and support the annual Association Open House in October.
- Support any committee you are selected for by the Association President.
- Based on your attendance at the above activities, you will accrue points to maintain your standing in the department. **One point is accumulated for each event attended, it is expected that a new member accumulates 85 points in the first 12 months.** Failure to do so may result in your status being changed or expulsion from the Association.
