New Applicant Procedure:

- Complete the application w/ your current certifications and driver's license photo copy attached.
- You will be contacted for an in-person interview by the Membership Committee.
- After your interview you will be presented as a new applicant at the next monthly Association business meeting. At this time your application will be tabled for one month while a background check and interview are conducted.
- The following monthly business meeting your application for membership will be voted on by our membership.
- The final step will be to present you as a new member to the Town of Perinton Board and the receipt of the letter indicating that you have been added to the Town's Workers Compensation Policy.
- After receipt of this letter you will be able to participate in Association activities as an active member.
- Prior to your full participation you will need to complete and pass a physical examination.

Training Requirements:

- During the 1st year you will be required to attend the Fire Fighter 1 (FF1) class at the Monroe County Public Training Facility. If only wanting to be an exterior firefighter or fire police member this training is not needed.
- The FF1 class is (2) nights a week for approximately 13 weeks. Each class is approximately 3 hours long and attendance is mandatory.
- The Association meets every 1st, 3rd and 4th Monday evening at 7:30 PM for firematic training activities. It is highly recommended that you attend the Monday training sessions prior to your acceptance into the Association.
- Truck maintenance is conducted twice a month on Sunday mornings beginning at 8:30 AM. You will be placed on 1 of 3 teams that take care of this. It is highly recommended that you attend as many of these sessions prior to your acceptance into the Association.

Member Duties

- Attend the Monthly Business Meeting held on the 2nd Monday of the month. The meetings start at 7:30 PM at Station #1
- Attend and participate in the monthly training drills.
- Attend work details that are announced by the Chief during the year.
- Attend the annual hose test work detail in May.
- Attend and support the annual Association Open House in October.
- Attend and support the annual Turkey Raffle Party in November.
- Support any committee you are selected for by the Association President.
- Based on your attendance at the above activities, you will accrue points to maintain your standing in the department. **During your first year of active duty you will be required to accrue 200 points.** Failure to do so may result in your status being changed or expulsion from the Association.
